Roosevelt Park Community School Before & After School Care Program (Westview Child Care Centre)

Application Information

Westview Child Care Centre located in Roosevelt Park Community School will have 5 additional spaces available for Roosevelt Elementary School students starting on <u>Monday, May 1st</u> and be open from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Families who register will be able to continue having their children attend during the 2023-24 school year. In September, there will be an additional 7 spaces available for families.

School District 52, Westview Child Care Centre and Northern Health have established a partnership; as a result, there are 6 priority spaces for Northern Health children who attend Roosevelt Park Community School. Priority spaces will be granted to those defined as an "Eligible Person". Priority spaces are available to applicants who meet the "Eligible Person" definition defined as "any individual that is employed and identified by Northern Health within their operation in Prince Rupert.

For clarity, the defined "Eligible Person" has access to the 6 priority spaces only. Spaces will be designated on a first come, first served basis with priority given to those applications where the parents work extended dayshifts 0700-1900 hours.

Families seeking admission to the before and after school care program must complete an application form from the Childcare Provider (Westview Child Care Centre). If a family is requesting a priority space, they must also complete an online verification form provided by Northern Health to the Childcare Provider, which will allow Northern Health to verify their eligibility for the additional space. <u>Registration packages can be</u> <u>picked up at Westview Child Care Centre between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.</u> When registration for the before and after school care program first opens, the priority spaces (6 spaces) will all be filled by eligible persons and additional spaces will be filled by members of the general school population.

When all the spaces are filled, a waitlist will be created. Within the waitlist, applicants will be designated as either an eligible person who works extended dayshift, works traditional hours or a member of the general public. As spaces in the before and after school care program become available, the Childcare Provider will consult the waitlist and select the appropriate person to fill the space based on the balance of priority access and general school community access spaces.
